It means using vegetable inks that are completely petroleum-free. It means using wash-up solutions that are made from bean and seed esters that come from American farms. It means that VOC (volatile organic compounds) emissions are almost zero.

It means our air and water are safer.

HOW WE'RE DIFFERENT

What is green printing? Some people think it means using soy inks and recycled paper...but it's so much more.

Decades before others were paying attention to environmental issues, Consolidated implemented an Environmental Vision and Management Policy that has resulted in the following:

- We eliminated the use of thousands of gallons of petroleum by using 100% vegetable-based inks, ink pigments, press wash-up solutions.
- We reuse or recycle 100% of our paper waste.
- We receive virtually 100% of our paper via sustainably harvested forests.
- We reduced our overall energy consumption by at least 20%.
- We completely eliminated all hazardous waste water.
- We use recycled restaurant cooking oil and alcohol-free and petroleum-free solutions.
- We eliminated harmful toxins and carcinogens from our entire printing process.
- We use recyclable inks and toners, and ink sludge is recycled into roofing tiles, asphalt or park benches.
- We renovated our offices using non-toxic, recycled and energy-efficient materials.
